Welcome to AWE-1

The 1st American Workshop on Ellipsometry (AWE-1) will be held February 28 – March 3, 2027, at the Conference Center on the Nebraska Innovation Campus in Lincoln, Nebraska.

AWE-1 is the inaugural workshop & exhibition organized and sponsored by the [North American Ellipsometry Association \(NAEA\)](#). It is further endorsed by the [American Vacuum Society \(AVS\)](#) as the First Topical Conference & Exhibition of the [Spectroscopic Ellipsometry Technical Group](#). This meeting brings together experienced leaders, early-career professionals, and students across academic, public, and industrial sectors to learn, exchange, and share scientific and technological knowledge, as well as recent advancements, in ellipsometry, polarimetry, and related techniques. Anticipated attendance is between 100 and 150 participants, ranging from experts to beginners.

The [Technical Program](#) includes complimentary [Tutorials](#), Oral and Poster Sessions with a [Keynote](#), [101 Lectures](#), and [Invited Talks](#). An [Awards Ceremony](#) will celebrate an inaugural [NAEA Fellow](#), recipient of the [Rasheed M. A. Azzam Medal](#), and multiple [Student Awardees](#). A simultaneous [Industry Exhibition](#) will showcase the latest equipment developments.

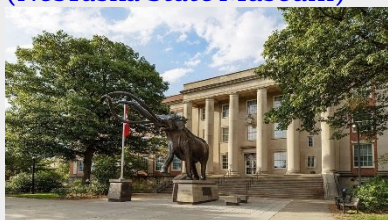

Industry Exhibition

AWE-1 will feature a simultaneous [Industry Exhibition](#) on Monday and Tuesday, March 1–2, 2027, showcasing the latest equipment developments in ellipsometry, polarimetry, and related techniques that utilize polarized light to characterize bulk materials, thin films, surfaces, interfaces, and nanostructures under both static and dynamic conditions. Novelties may cover instrumentation and data analysis concepts, as well as applications across physics, chemistry, materials science, life sciences, engineering, and metrology.

The [Industry Exhibition](#) will be set up in the Banquet Hall of the Conference Center on the Nebraska Innovation Campus—directly adjacent to the Auditorium where Oral Sessions are held, and in the same space where Coffee Breaks and Lunches are served and where the Poster Session takes place. This naturally overlapping setting ensures steady attendee traffic throughout all exhibit hours.

As a first-time event, we have planned for generous exhibit space in relation to the anticipated attendance. Booths will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. All booths include standard electrical outlets, Wi-Fi, and nearby waste disposal.
